### Voice as Physical Action Open Sessions with Frank Camilleri

**The Open Sessions** are open to anyone who is interested in working on the voice via actor-training techniques. A set number of exercises will be transmitted with the aim of equipping participants with skills and tools that are essential to the craft of theatre. These exercises are aimed at enhancing flexibility, flow of energy, attention, interaction, and sensitivity to tempo and rhythm. This work will serve as a basis for vocal and song work. Vocal and song techniques (such as text articulation, voice energy, rhythm) will be transmitted within the parameters of the work on intentions and physical actions. The sessions will also include demonstrations of work.

**Frank Camilleri** has been doing theatre since 1989. He has worked with, amongst others, John Schranz, Lechek Raczak, Ingemar Lindh, and Jola Cynkutis. He has performed, delivered workshops and theory courses in Malta and abroad (including Italy, Poland, UK, Greece, Estonia, and Slovenia), since 1994. In 2001 he launched Icarus Performance Project (Malta) whose research in performance processes and actor technique has been presented in Poznan (Poland), Exeter (UK), Moscow (Russia), and Evora (Portugal). He is Academic Coordinator of Theatre Studies at the University of Malta where he specialises in the praxis of theatre-making. [www.icarusproject.info](http://www.icarusproject.info)
